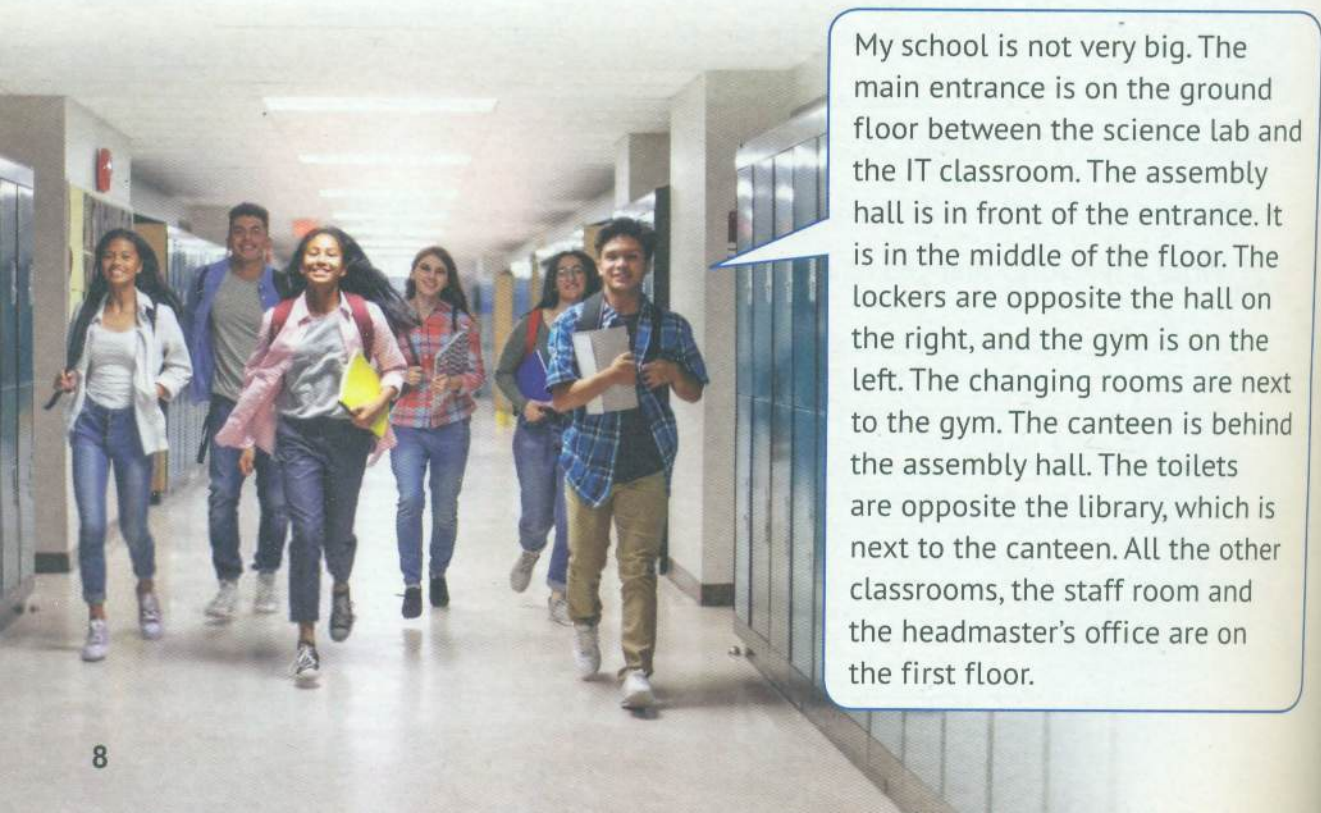

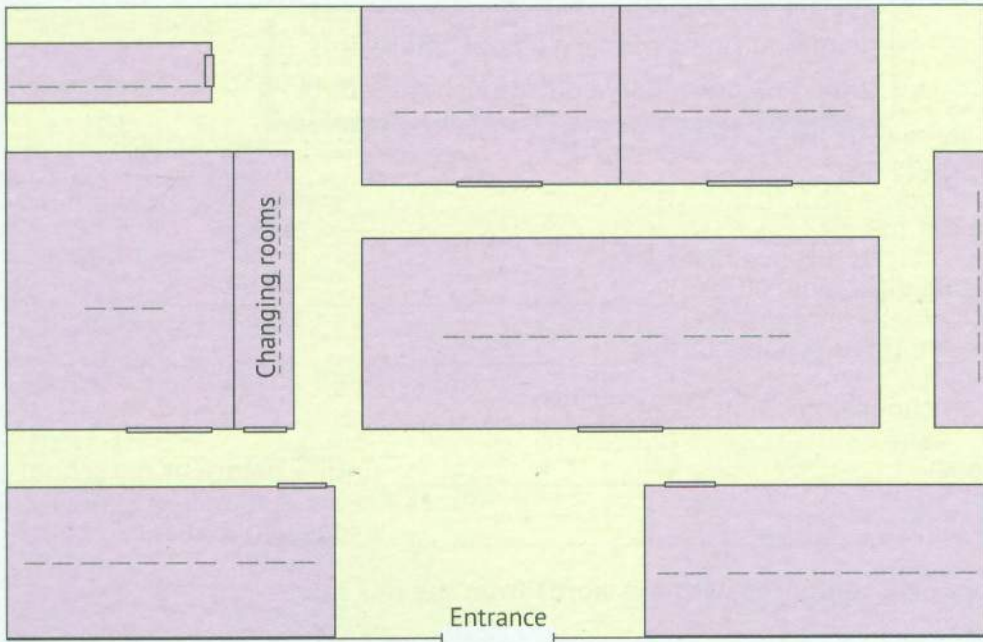
What other rooms can there be at a school?
